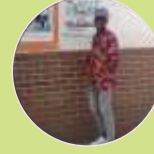

# "Rehabs and Religion"

## Causes & Delays in the Devolution of Dacha

The secret is put in plain sight as daily headlines move away from Cannabis arrests to conversations that construct new highs on a Cannabis front from a Hemp hotel to a humming birds bite on the space cookies the road to a Cannabis revolution is getting busier and smoother by the day. But like the road which the souls drift on these terrains, the realities promised are lined with the balances of pitfalls and fallacies of false hopes. Yet still the Manoeuvres call is to ascend in alignment with ever shifting constructs, a debacle of landmines in reveals and seals bordering incognito yet still morphing to asphalt facilitating the traction.

The journey to morphing mental constructs is an everyday wage paid by the conscious desires for unending connections with the truth in the moment. Seemingly founded like new, the returning is only an alignment bringing a balance and a bridge for a new glance. It is from this standpoint that in revisitation we see the thirst in the present realities flagging as red stops on the pathway to the green. In sequencing the cohabitation of the shades of the rainbow speaks not to belittle any spectrum but to reflect a balancing in the order of creation and perfection in positioned purpose. It is no mystery that Cannabis in the modern timelines speaks to billions in human valuations. A wealth accelerator on multidimensions it is such in this world of the fiat, that the paramount fingering in remuneration around the roots of the herb positions as an obstacle in opposition. Rehabilitation Centres and Religion singling out in practice Christianity as the present front where accelerated information sharing to facilitate the desired freedoms of the Cannabis plant is needed.

"Who are against us in this legalisation journey? We have come to the conclusion that there are only two groups against us, that is the Rehab Centres because they are going to lose a lot of money. The government always used to send young people caught for Cannabis to Rehab Centres at their own expense, the Rehab Centres made a lot of money, that's them".

In approaching the second narration Myrtle Clarke slows down her approach on the PlantX Radio discussion as she indicates the next obstacle on the pathway of freeing Cannabis. "The second group of people I am very sorry to say is the Christians, very conservative Christians not other religions. We

see incredible opposition from big religious organisations".

In a call for balance in association of cognitive freedoms Myrtle Clarke further extends the call to privacy in practice further stating that; "we need those Christians out there to stand up and support our community and support our plant. Go into your religious community and remind them that this plant is in the bible and remind them that they cannot keep opposing us because they are arguing on the wrong side of history".

Talking to the sides of history the astronomical changes speak not only to the return of plants in Cannabis in relevance but an inevitable change in the processional order of the times. Obstacles will fall away and mental frameworks assimilate new puzzle pieces demystifying the maze, a bringing of clarity seen with the Cannabis daybreak revolution and the slowed sequencing transmitting the gazes thirsting in the present devolution of Dacha.

# PODIUMS AND PROPOSALS 05 MOTION MATEKWANE ADVANCEMENTS IN MPUMALANGA WITH PURE MAKEDA

Pure Makeda a conduit positioning as a channel for cannabis in the Kingdom of KwaNdebele held a gathering on their founding grounds. The gathering themed with a vision to share on the potential that cannabis promises not just for the nation of the Manala and Ndzundza but to the people in the kingdom there to. In the order of fitting names, who else to rise to the call of ushering a royal plant back to Royalty would be taskly named? A Queen in her own right rises as Sheba Madon Mashinini with a business workshop positioning cannabis in Agriculture in Siyabuswa, in the province of Mpumalanga South Africa. The event bouldering AFASA (African Farmers Association of South Africa) called on local farmers to find an opportunity to learn about agricultural compliance and patent protection with regard to the Cannabis plants. Seen in grace through the attendance of the Mayoress of the town Nomsa Mtsweni and the local municipality administrators and also witnessing representatives from the Royal house and members of the community. The guests at the event found access to mind altering information that in functioning freed the cannabis plant is someway from the mental cages of indoctrination and stigma. In conversation with KannaXpress post the business workshop event held in Siyabuswa Mpumalanga, Queen Sheba indicated that "the nation has been blindfolded into labeling cannabis as a drug and we as Pure Makeda feel the need to share information and the opportunities of goodness found

in the cannabis plant". "One of those promises is the pathway to strengthen the monarchy hierarchy that is losing its economic grasp by the day". A remark that Queen Sheba issues with a hind sight gaze at the promised outcomes from the much referred to Cannabis Phakisa gathering. In indications and promises of restructuring policies in adherence with the motioning towards freedom for the Ganja herb. It is no doubt that given the presence of arable land under the governance of royal houses; there lives potential in ACTS that in actualisation could see the land under the guide of the royal houses unlock economic value through the cultivation of Cannabis plants. Such an organic working model could present a shift that will witness the royal custodians of the land on which the herb is grown junction to pathways of economic tributaries from the operations. This is not new in functionality and in particular in the province of Mpumalanga where through a divided system mining houses lease land from farmers for the tenure of the mineable life with tributary arrangements in place. The arrival of cannabis into the discussion presents differing dynamics on an economic restructuring front as the plant promises heights of glory in the pursuit of synergies as government and the grey merge to strengthen communities. On merging efforts and collaboration in the realization of a bigger picture Pure Makeda indicated that a hybridize trade and trace model in coherence with the Grow One Africa model they are

positioning to enable the unlocking of land value under the same ethos. Queen Sheba already pioneering in her community through various non-profit activities that embody poetry, dancing together with an academic front accelerating the young minds in numerology and literacy has been a beacon of light for her community. This high-level engagement in the collaboration with Royalty is facilitated under the merits of the Ndzundza Mabhoko Royal family in the traditional leadership of Ikosi January Mahlangu. In full circle discussions on the grow plans, patent recognition remarks emerge as Queen Sheba talks to discussions with the Council for Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) that will see the possible availing of a strain to be prototyped in the province of Mpumalanga. The provincial sectoring of grow areas is a growing referral to the federal jurisdictional battles in the wages of cannabis policies at a global scale, a partitioning that allows partial liberties with the herb seen in freedoms of open doors in the KwaZulu-Natal Province. In a twist in the tales of provinces here at KannaXpress we welcome Mpumalanga to the cannabis agricultural potential that could speak a new lease of life to the ash by-product & the coal power stations and the neverminded mine rehabilitation. The pathways to potentials in application with regard to cannabis reaching the masses

# GREEN WASHING WEED 06

## SIMON LOXTON REMEMBERED

When I shadowed in documenting the journey of a football team to a championship title, I woke up to the realities of sports washing, and the laundry business of formalizing the informal in cash and brands in exchanges of hands meeting in the grey corridors of subjects liable to interpretation. The process in exchange of sporting world incomes in the kiss of the greys and government was a phenomenon that led one to wonder at the potentials of the laundromat. Enter the minerals trade space and wealth in gold is mafiad under the same ethos, value trade lines breached in the absence of standardized assemble lines of formality. Walking into the plant world we find the avocado boundary lines with the Kola nut crews build trade lines of defense protecting the value acquisition bottled in the capture of nature's gift. The wrestling is a norm in supposed exchanges on a front where chaos is the order of the way as self-regulation and copy and paste models are presented in sorting prototypes to address the growing needs of the cannabis consumers. The grapple of the cannabis plant in a bid to line up for irradiation on a front that qualifies the blossoms certified as medical grade compliant is popping up as the new norm in one-way trips for certification and take-off. A norm not only on the South African plains that have witnessed the shipping of the cannabis flower between grow operations and off-take compliant plants for processing and final delivery to the "destination", blinking the imaginary borderlines in trades triangulating between

Uruguay's and Australia via South Africa. A reality in dynamism that witnessed the global pharmaceutical regulatory authorities battle to enforce stop and check measures through coupling of track and trace models to monitor, evaluate and assess the plant development and status across differing stages in the grow process. A soon to be norm in surging surveillance and market freedoms of the cannabis now at the door of for formal appearance. The surge and bloom of grow-ops and government cannabis yields has saturated a market with cannabis flowers that fit the alignment in compliance grows, but are faced with huddles in off takes. On the mirrored end the band of brothers with facilities positioned with the priority rights and off take channels find a growing incapacitation to meet the surging demands for cannabis and value-added products. A fusion in challenges and solutions meddling once again in the presenting indicators that lead the cannabis plant to model its functionality for formal appearance through loaning for another grow operation and returning for accolades at the end of the season. In the continuing fights for its freedoms, it is not a mystery that still in pursuit of compliance the cannabis flower lines up for some light ray washes as it receives the tags to the dreamland in certifications of analysis. The same complications birthed in attempts to dam the waters of the plants as conflicts of opinions and sandboxes aim to unbox solutions needing no green tainting machinery



Here at the Fields of Green for ALL office, we were shocked and devastated to hear of the death of a pioneer. A Cannabis enthusiast extraordinaire, a crazy character who lived and breathed the Plant, who knew about terpenes before any of us. He cultivated the dankest of the dank. His glass collection drew gasps from those who dab. His profound knowledge of everything – from the roots to the vapour – set Simon apart right from those very early days.

The year was 2012 and Jules & I were doing our very first presentation in Cape Town, on the rooftop of a backpackers in Long Street. We were super nervous before the event, and I thought a little puff of what was going around would help calm the jitters. Little did I know that that would be my first taste of Cape Town Cheese, and the cultivator was Mr Loxton himself. Jules was furious with me as I tried to pull myself together to go on stage. The MC on that day was a very funny man called Werner Weber – he had me glugging water to try to straighten up enough to speak. The Dagga Couple became firm friends with the grower and the comedian; Simon and Werner joined me as the first directors of Fields of Green for ALL when we registered our non-profit the following year. Simon was a quiet activist who had his fair share of run-ins with the law. There was a deep understanding of the horrors of prohibition between us. In 2015 we travelled to Spain together, visiting our very first

Cannabis Social Club – Betty Boop in Barcelona. Simon had visited there before and couldn't wait to take us to our very first club. We knew as we got through the access control that we were home amongst our people, and that private clubs are the way to go in South Africa. Simon went on to establish a Betty Boop here in SA. It's so great that he got to live his dream. That time in Barcelona we also went to our first Spannabis Expo and had our minds blown at the scale and potential for all things weed. I've become somewhat blasé about expos since then, but the first Spannabis was wow! 2023 is the Year of the OG. Cheers Si, an OG of note! Your passion would drive Jules mad sometimes – "Does he think of nothing else!?" – I can hear Jules say. We soldiered around in the wilderness in those early years, but I always knew that if I needed an answer to a technical question about anything to do with our beloved Plant, Si was the man. To Matt, you have lost a bother and your mom has lost a son. We're sending love. We're also thinking of the team at Betty Boop. May Simon's legacy live on – thanks for trusting his crazy ideas! # 07 ZUNGU & THE VIEWS SWAZI CANNABIS WINDS

**B**orn in the South West Township and schooled in the Matsapa Swaziland Xolile Zungu emerges from a maternal farming lineage that sees his mother being one of the pioneering female farmers in the current Kingdom of eSwatini. Growing up in the

agricultural environment he found inspiration in the exposure and experience facilitated by his mother and in 1996 having had the first kiss of cannabis Kufu Zungu found a love affair with the cannabis herb that had him rest cigarettes and alcohol given the absence of meditation in the consumption of the later; further indicating that the kiss has been bliss since that moment. After completing his Matric Zungu indicates that his return to SOWETO took the corporate route in pathways that never felt like home as he found himself as a stray coordinate in the work places, indicating that his happy days where the moments when he would facilitate the highs at the work place. "On my journey waiting for permanent placement I suddenly lost passion in the municipal IT department in the library I just got inspired by the books and said let me start my own thing". That was the beginning of the homing procedure in pathways working towards centering the cannabis herb as the core of his journey to which he references as a "higher calling".

Thus arrives the inception of The Bush Doctor Industries inspired by the reggae music legend Peter Tosh and as if on que the symmetries from the informatics in the IT training find a new hum in online sales. Offramping along the operational ground research on the trade of cannabis, Zungu was left disgruntled by the state of trade within the informal physical market after meeting a few Rastafari and white people coupled by the uncertainty in transactional operations. "I had to change the game so I started putting everything online, I sold online without meeting anyone because I was scared, this is a new thing, the government is delaying to legalise, the government is legalizing partially, there is police

brutality, there is set up, people you know might snitch on you"; citations put forward as the technicalities that informed the digital approach to The Bush Doctor Industries. After realising the first transaction in the Cape ends of South Africa, Zungu indicates that the herb dealing journey has been rippled by referrals and recommendations from one end-user to the next finding balance in the elaborated responsibilities he carries as an outlet for over fifty farmers in the Kingdom of Eswatini. "I am more of a healer, I am a person who can teach one how to heal using cannabis" states Kufu as he talks boiling and oil extraction further stating to KannaXpress that "I am well known overseas, locally, in the Kingdom of Eswatini, Southern Africa is aware of me". Given the dynamics of his trade network we found room to ask Xolile Zungu about his desired outcomes in the legislative framework put forward in governing the Cannabis herb and the industry as a whole; this looking at the past and the present with the proposed working document issued on the 11th of September and its future promises to the plants and the freedoms of the people of the plant? "I wouldn't say this is legalisation, it's just a mind pacifier whereby they are just relaxing one so that there is no fighting and one thinks they are on the matter". This partial legalisation makes sure that one is not dealing and protects the cannabis community from police brutality this an indication that Zungu refers to as the balance in the present framework.

# 08 TURNING WHEELS OF WEED TERMS

As the gates of September opened, the mandate within the cannabis discussions seemed to accelerate in official documents churning out within a week of the other following the silence that heralded the trumpeted gathering in the Cannabis Phakisa. The Cannabis social spaces and headlines were awash with taglines and group communications talking to the end of Cannabis arrests coded in SAPS directives and proposed bills appearing as working documents redefining with clearer sentences in timelines and rands for breaching proposed cannabis affiliation guidelines.

Appearing a week before the 5th year anniversary date in tandem with the 911 encounters the working documents bring clarity to terms of reference and smogs of some fuzziness in the reveal of the proposed sentences for playing ball outside the court, with 10 years looking like the top count and R2000 as the cap in penalties. The expungement emerges with options of conditional submission for repeal from the cannabis criminals record, a reset button that positions to resume the count again in the continued criminalization of the plant. In other terms it presents opportunities of freedoms for those incarcerated on the grounds of

affiliation with cannabis with rights of refusal still lounging in the hands of the state.

Turning to the directive of the SAPS there was jubilation in the corner of Ras Riddim as he joined the list of owners receiving their cannabis bud back; the grounds of standardization are still sketchy are the indications from Ras Riddim who was detained at Jeppe Police Station in Johannesburg over the weekend, he spoke to KannaXpress after his release. "It is clear that the directive works as I witnessed the same people who arrested me being the very ones who signed the documentation for the release of my cannabis back to me as they directed me to their storage department. This is an indication that this Phakisa outcome works bringing to mind that I also overheard the police officers talking amongst each other over a workshop they had attended with regard to cannabis arrests". In a video on the 7LKXPX Youtube Channel a provision from the elder after the recovery of his herb Ras Riddim is seen cutting open the SAPS branded seal bag in a procedural order to free the herb from the bag. If this possible returning of the herb could speak to the changes in the operational procedures within the arms of the state, a brighter ray can be seen by



those robbed of the light of day under the banner of the herb. It must be noted that in milestones and documents that seek to bring clarity and unlock the Cannabis plant potential on a privacy and economic scale this calendar year presents progress in maybe not deliverables as of yet, but discussion that shift the trajectory of the Ganja yatch. The isolation of low THC containing cannabis from the proposed Private use working Bill document not only shortens the bill but sandboxes interested communities along lines of specialization. The ripple in the promise of Agricultural providence

that could face delta ray challenges presented in this hemisphere whilst providing working material and by products to prototype revolutions in associated industries looking to springboard on the Hemp revolution. As the regulation of a plant and in particular cannabis brings with it special dynamics that call for an invention of the wheel never mind rethinking the old parameters it must be handed in appreciation that the terms in the wheels of weed are turning.

Talking to changes that have seen the cannabis herb house homes across its multistate of existence in the cannabis communities, causes and effects of suspended sections of the constitution and plant prohibition procedures Xolile Zungu states that "it has changed a bit but I am not 100% happy, in Amsterdam they are enjoying the benefits of being free with the herb but this side we are still limited, is it because we are Africa? Surprisingly and the funny part is that the best herb and hemp that is found here in Africa not in Amsterdam or Canada. where there are sped up technical systems in the application of cannabis trade licenses, here one has to struggle for a license. Hence, I say we are partially free as the Herb Freedom Fighters but we are not fully free" The same freedoms that in time need to talk to the freeing of the plants as a whole and not exclusionary affiliation in the use

and content characteristics of the plant. In the moment this is the journey of the cannabis herb on its trajectory to find a home amongst its people on all fronts from growers to the ganja gogos, as shared through the experiences of Xolile Zungu.
