



he herb ignites to the whistle of the puffer, a scenario in the homes of the many across Africa as blissfully they reconnect with the beauty of life in its existence and the unveiling of perceptions in their assent. The descent in the bites and the ascent in the puff keeps the scores as the munchies warm the bench sitters making homes on touchlines as they welcome the freedom found in reconnecting with the Ganja and fathoming the possibilities questioning the dew of the morning grass.

The realities of a Cannabis plant on a regeneration are witnessed on most, seldom we say all the states of Africa, the green thread of trade, raids, the unpaid and the privileged mingle on the cross roads of stadiums talking to legalisation and maybe open participation. On the green and white stripes of Nigeria we find a Cannabis movement anchoring on the social synergies presented by the Cannabis connection as they curate expressive events talking to the arts in music and dance.

On another wing the Bang conversations at a state level are simmering in the affairs as Tinubu muscles into office to find the reserves in shelved Cannabis discussions kickstarted by Princess Miriam Onuhoa at the House of Representatives in May 2020 stating that "this Cannabis Control Bill when passed will be useful for our pharmaceutical companies for products that will enhance healthy living as our country join the league of nations in embracing the good side of this (Cannabis) farming".

In a discussion with XKanna Ziggy Machala the founder of Cannaville, an organisation in Nigeria positioned to sensitize the people of the land on cannabis; XKanna soaks in waves of intents relayed at Cannaville Nigeria as founded in the envisioning of the organisation anchoring in the hope that one day Cannabis will be legally accepted in Nigeria, howbeit eventually. The thrust in these times of information battles is welcomed by the Cannaville community as Ziggy openly states; "we can be on the war front, teaching people the many potentials of the cannabis industry".



Keeping the motion in the volatile box Machala points to the penalty spot as she considers the potentials of an open Cannabis economy in Nigeria stating that "as far as cannabis is concerned in Nigeria, it is still very illegal and we're a long way away from legalization. Possession and distribution of cannabis will literally lead to jail, with consideration of the quantity that one is found with".

The Anslinger campaign in full throttle is still a reality that is witnessed in times of change sparked by new minds and times, reevaluating the propaganda births the rise of a shepherd free furred nation pushing for plant liberties in unprecedented models.

In continuing indications of realities towards plant freedoms Ziggy references the discussions defragmenting the stocks on the neck of Ganja as she alphabetically notes huddles and the pains in the criminalization of cannabis in the muscled connotations reflecting the abys of plant wars. "Currently, there aren't any conversations regarding freeing the cannabis plant, all attempts including the Cannabis Control Bill to legalize it in the parliament in 2023 were faced with major setbacks. Therefore, there aren't any opportunities that are presented for the general public. The only people who are benefiting from cannabis in Nigeria are colluding cartels and their partners running the black market".

The clamping of Cannabis within the state has however not deterred various brand affiliations as the pioneers emerging from the green and white flagged nation fly the Bang colors in bliss. Ziggy concludes with the acknowledgement of such disparity stating that "despite the fact that some of our Nigerian celebrities like Burna Boy are on the frontline of cannabis brands globally, there is no progress towards the official embrace of Cannabis here in Nigeria.

It's been a fruitless process so far and corruption and stigmatization are definitely huge barriers to the development of the cannabis industry in Nigeria. The social and cultural stigma around cannabis is deeply ingrained in the country, and the government's corruption makes it difficult to create any kind of legal framework that would actually work."

On the ancient stone houses in Zimbabwe the conversations see the flower power call rallies sound beyond the Pied Pipers Ruva Rangu (My Flower) melodies; teams formulate to kick the ball on discussions around Cannabis with a Hemp genetical reference. The facilitations of information exchange gatherings in conferences, tours and seminars towards the unlocking of the Hemp participation opportunities have shroomed. The opening days of 2024 have seen an acceleration that is witnessing two different organisations rolling out initiatives talking to pathways on plant policy adherence and participation opportunities with Reference to Hemp. In what would be a pre-match discussion to consider the upcoming fixture and the state of the Hemp potential and participation opportunities for teams in Zimbabwe, University of Joburg based Davison centers with references pointing to the stigmas affiliated with Cannabis stating that "when people say one has smoked something, that is ridiculing people because Hemp is not as toxic as these other drugs, in fact it is not a drug at all it's a plant which can be used in versatile applications". Returning to the founding purpose birthing the workshop Davison indicates that "our vision is to have people producing a significant amount of Hemp in 2024 season, we believe that we need to start preparing people to go into production. Right now, people are not producing Hemp, we want to

In the past accolade awarding displays the Zimbabwe Industrial Hemp Trust pioneered discussions on Cannabis a feature that witnessed them receive an exhibition honor for a Hemp oriented design at the Zimbabwe International Trade Fair. The farming of Cannabis in Zimbabwe is active beyond the landrace terrains of Binga as forums and farmers unions have been fielded to feed the Cannabis oil processing plant commissioned by the

2024 marks an election year for South Africa and the mandates at such times normally snail pace in bill policy considerations decelerations with indications that whilst 2018 recorded 78 Bill in consideration, 2019 scratched the halfway attribute at 39 on the count. The gates in consultation towards the formulation of a Cannabis informative bill have been opened before.

The rejected Dr. Mario Oriani-Ambrosini proposition on the Medical Innovation Bill is one attribute that should alert the Cannabis enthusiasts and community on the continuing causes and intents to free the Cannabis plant. We might be at the frontline of another drive but we are on the ends of many faces that have pushed the intents to free the herb.

The grandstanding could consider bowing to hold hands as frontlines and faces change but the mandate to relay the plant moves along. On the 19th of January the 2020 tabled Cannabis Bill 19B closed another chapter of consultations but still faces a churning journey all before an assent to the states president's office. One wonders who it will find at the echelons, if at all the bill would be able to arrive at those docks past the House of Assembly towards assention by the President. The hope is found in the indications now more than ever that display the willingness from the

Now to the tapping of potential financial licks with the introduction of cashless society, the primary power of Cannabis in the capitalism system might be land on a podium presenting a possible governance. The question in digitizing considers the formulation of clusters in the hubs mimicking fifteenminute cities as communal collaboration could bring to life once again visions like Rafael Caro Quintero with no NDAs and bounties in the millions.

The drug war on Cannabis has almost always been a diplomatic reference towards controlling the Capitalism narrative and with the doors of capitalism on the collapse financial fiat cartels are gathering to curb the system and

Talking to the Hemp potentials and participation opportunities pinging in Zimbabwe that are anchored in the presence of both high THC and Low THC cannabis under medicinal Cannabis classification and Hemp on an Agri-industrial fold the narrations from Davison are that Grow Money's training of farmers in Zimbabwe is for the participants to go into Hemp production as he references two sub categories of participation portfolios. "We want farmers to come into Hemp for seed and fiber or into Hemp for flowers". This he states with mention of an eco-system talking to actualisation beyond the workshop through presentations of incubations and value chain coupling looking to actualise permit and offtakes housed in letters of intents and varying funding models. "We will roll out and buy the final produce from the original farmer through contract farming models in synergy with banking houses in Zimbabwe".

Now to the Island of Mauritius that evidently still has a tight grasp on Cannabis plant regulation, the country positions the plant alongside synthetic substances in scheduling. The uncommissioned community in the supply and demand circle of the herb is operational and visible to the knowers as would seemingly be across various Berlin conferenced statelines in Africa.

The entry participatory tickets into the Cannabis game presents indoor flower pouch packs sufficient for one joint that pack a stint in the match from six to eight equivalent in US dollars cross rating at three hundred and fifty Mauritian Rupees. The tickets in the bud pockets are exchanged through tightly regulated circles of fans that still chant the songs of Ganja in the Island bellowing the unwavering existence of Gandia on the rise. A stoner who recently returned from a living trial at the Island of Mauritius spoke to XKanna stating that "When I saw some patrons at the restaurant where I was having a meal looking like fans of the Green Team, I approached them for directions to the ticketing office, I was right and with the herb fan recognition they pointed me to the network; I must indicate that discretion in reality is still the key when smoking Cannabis on this Mauritian turf". Marijuana has run her own underground currency for generations and with this flood in the green gold waters covering African states now embraced in features tucking the Cannabis plant into political campaigns, it is only time that stands between the seed and the harvest. Such realities exemplified in promises uttered by the losing aspirant George Wajackoyah in his Presidency campaign within the confines of Kenya state that; "Cannabis carries a potential to save the ailing economy of Kenya and solve some of the challenges we are facing as a country".


This remark stands reflectively true for the greater nations in Africa amidst skewed trade agreements and adherence policies inherited from colonial frameworks Cannabis presents a reset where nations have the opportunities to formulate their own rules and refereeing on the Cannabis industrialization front.

Speaking on the calls to action from the conference Malyo indicates that the rolling out of outcomes and the resolutions witnessed the organisers of the conference submitting a letter to the new government office in the Presidential Delivery Unit (PDU).

The PDU is a Zambian presidency portfolio positioned to accelerate the ascendancy of matters to the statesman, "our request for an engagement and information sharing gathering was approved, I attended the meeting with the (ZamHemp) Director, the intents indicate that the state of This season of greening must consider evolutions that will see that the harm to mankind has been in banning the Cannabis herb from participating in the everyday lives of this Ai civilization. In the water damaged crop there are presentations talking to threats beyond the commercialisation of the Cannabis crop and the opportunities prevailing



The Swazi Gold is a famed landrace from the Kingdom that supplies vast corners of the world with Cannabis buds and amazingly Eswatini is still to enact an intentional policy drive to unlock the Cannabis economy and free the crop. The time is December and there are reports of a high winds and water having swept through the heart of the Kingdom and past the regions of Ngculwini, after Hhelehhele on the road to big Bend.

The morning after sees roofs of houses displaced and fields of green levelled as the actualities in crop loses and water damage rise with the daybreak. The continuing rains presented grow and curing challenges in the final two months of 2023 as the farmers and facilitators on the Eswatini value chain where required to restrategize and reinvestment in resources and deliverables.

A Cannabis facilitator and free thinking Kufu Zungu meddling between the Kingdom of Eswatini and South Africa connects with XKANNA to express the high rain water situation from their grows. "We have had Heavy rains and storms in Eswatini and this has definitely affected our Cannabis crop yields". Kufu continues to narrate that their farming operations were affected in November whereas the rains are still continuing to wreck damage in the present. In response to the damage the indications from Kufu Zungu are that they have had to "replant fast" this he says with indications that the hand of man play might be present in the clouds. With grassroots conversation indicative of a definite damage to crops and an alteration to weather patterns Ras Riddim connects with XKANNA from Port St. Johns in the Eastern Cape province of South Africa remarking that "If this is the act of God we ask for mercy or is this the Climate change that was being spoken of? Our Cannabis crop has been damaged, it's going to be another drought season again this year. This he says also referencing the mealie fields that present a primary food staple in provisions.

Swinging back to Cannabis Riddim in the Ras states "we are not getting an opportunity to plant replacement seedlings all we can do is care for the remaining Cannabis plants and clear the area of unwanted weeds".

Crop replacement on one end and salvaging on another, the works of higher rainfalls and water damage on the Cannabis plants. A Cannabis Club founder in anonymity spoke to XKANNA on the Cannabis yields coming in from the Kingdom of Eswatini with lines considering caution on consumption due to high humid conditions in the air and altered curing conditions.

So many aspects come into the fold when water presents its presence on plants with a high fall count.

The plea to the Prime Creator from Ras Riddim is for mercy, the concern from Snoux Poswa is the absence of crop insurance in moments like these whereas Kufu Zungu considers an introspection into the influence of man on the weather and the rains wreaking havoc on Cannabis crops.







MAXIMIZING YOUR CANNABIS YIELD THE CRUCIAL ROLE OF TRAINING AND TOPPING DURING THE VEGETATIVE STAGE

Cannabis cultivation has witnessed a surge in popularity over recent years, thanks to the increasing acceptance of its medicinal and recreational use. Whether you're a seasoned grower or a beginner, understanding the plant's growth stages is vital for optimizing yield. Before diving into vegging and the specifics of training techniques, it's essential to understand some fundamental concepts:

1. Promoting Healthy Growth:

Training techniques such as low-stress training (LST) and high-stress training (HST) can be employed during this stage to manipulate the plant's shape, optimize light penetration, and encourage lateral branching. LST involves gently bending branches away from the centre of the plant, while HST methods like topping involve removing or pinching off the main stem's tip.

2. Enhancing Light Distribution:

By training your cannabis plants early on, you create an even canopy that allows more light to reach lower branches. Adequate light distribution results in fuller growth throughout the plant's structure instead of just focusing on the uppermost parts.

3. Controlling Height:

Topping refers to cutting off the main apical bud at an early age when it has developed several nodes below it. This technique encourages bushier growth by stimulating multiple colas (flowering sites). Topped plants exhibit more uniform height distribution and are less likely to outgrow their vertical space in indoor setups.

4. Encouraging Air Circulation:

An often-overlooked benefit of training and topping techniques is improved air circulation within the canopy. By manipulating the plant's shape, you create better airflow, which helps reduce humidity levels and minimizes the risk of pests or diseases.

Topping during vegetative stage:

Topping involves removing the tip of the main stem, encouraging lateral branch development. Follow these steps:

a) Wait until your plant has developed several sets of true leaves (typically three or four).

a) Main Stem: The primary vertical stem that runs from the base of the plant to its top.

b) Nodes: Points on the main stem where leaves or branches emerge.

c) Colas: Dense clusters of buds that form at the tips of branches.

The Vegetative Stage:

During the vegetative stage, which typically lasts 3-16 weeks depending on various factors including strain genetics, light cycle, and growing conditions, cannabis plants focus primarily on leafy growth rather than bud development. This phase sets the foundation for the plant's overall structure and determines its potential yield during flowering.

b) Sterilize sharp pruning shears with rubbing alcohol or hydrogen peroxide.

c) Identify the fifth or sixth node from the base of your plant and make a clean cut just above it.

d) Two new shoots will emerge from each side within a week. These will become new colas.

- Low-Stress Training (LST):

LST involves gently bending and securing branches to create a more even canopy, allowing light penetration and encouraging multiple colas. Here's how to do it:

a) Start LST during the vegetative stage when branches are still pliable.

b) Use soft gardening wire or plant ties to bend the branches horizontally away from the main stem.

c) Secure the bent branches using stakes or hooks, ensuring they remain in place without causing damage.

d) Continue adjusting and tying down branches as needed until you achieve an even canopy.

- Screen Of Green (SCROG):

SCROG is a high-yield training technique that utilizes a screen or mesh to support and manipulate cannabis plants. Follow these steps for SCROG success:

a) Install a screen above your plants at approximately 12-18 inches height during the early vegetative stage.

b) As your plants grow, weave them through the screen, tucking each branch under an open square.

c) Continue weaving until the entire screen is filled with growing tops.

d) Trim any growth underneath the screen to ensure optimal airflow and light penetration.



Training and topping your cannabis plants can significantly enhance both yield and quality by improving light distribution, maximizing bud production, and promoting overall plant health. Remember to tailor your approach based on strain characteristics, monitor plant response closely throughout the process, and always prioritize gentle techniques to prevent stress or damage. Mastering these techniques will undoubtedly elevate your cultivation skills and lead to bountiful harvests of top-quality cannabis



Transitioning to Flowering:

After a successful vegetative stage, it's time for your cannabis plants to transition into flowering. Proper training and topping during the previous stage play a crucial role in ensuring optimal bud development:

1. Increased Bud Sites:

By employing training techniques like LST or HST, you have encouraged lateral branching, resulting in an increased number of bud sites.

2. Balanced Canopy:

Training helps maintain a balanced canopy where light reaches all parts of the plant evenly. This ensures that buds develop uniformly across multiple colas rather than focusing solely on the uppermost portions.

3. Improved Light Penetration:

The low-stress training method allows lower branches to grow closer to the light source by bending them outwards instead of upwards. This maximizes photosynthetic efficiency throughout the plant and increases flower production.

Efficiently managing the vegetative stage of cannabis growth sets the groundwork for a successful flowering phase. Employing training and topping techniques during this period helps optimize light distribution, promote healthy growth, control vertical height, and enhance air circulation within the canopy—all factors that contribute significantly to maximizing yields during flowering.

Remember, each strain may respond differently to various training methods, so experimentation and observation are key. By investing time and effort into properly training your cannabis plants during their vegetative stage, you'll be rewarded with healthier plants and an abundant harvest when it comes time for flowering.

CANNABIS AND YOUTH: THEIR BRAINS ARE STILL DEVELOPING

In human beings, the brain undergoes numerous changes from birth until death. In the early stages of life, the neonatal period, the brain is only rudimentary, but through regular interactions and growth is developed.

Changes in cognitive and reasoning abilities define the teenage developmental period. During this time, adolescents exhibit natural and socially influenced curiosity, which may lead to increased vulnerability and risk exposure to substances such as alcohol and cannabis. Scientifically, the human brain undergoes important stages of development from early childhood.





Contrary to popular belief, the human brain does not reach full maturity until early adulthood. Neuroscientists suggest that the prefrontal cortex—the region responsible for executive functions like impulse control, decision-making, and risk assessment—continues developing until the mid-20s (up to 25). This prolonged maturation process highlights the vulnerability of young brains to external influences like alcohol, cannabis and other substances.

The different stages of human brain growth in neonates, children, adolescents, and adult individuals:

Brain Development in Neonates

The neonate developmental phase refers to the first 28 postnatal days when the brain is still highly adaptive to the new environment it has been exposed to. The weight of the human brain doubles within the first year of life. Repeated exposure to environmental cues is responsible for the development of synapses. The synapses tend to develop before birth and reach a peak before the neonate's fourth month. Over time, the fine motor pathways develop as redundant pathways regress. Thus, repetitive tasks help in the creation of redundant pathways, which become stronger.


Brain Development in Childhood

The brain undergoes significant critical growth in children between the ages of two and six. Over this period of development, the brain triples its weight. Language skills also develop at a very high level when children are at this age. The developmental process can be supported by nurturing the individual in multiple ways and offering access to different resources. Neglect does not facilitate cognitive development because the brain shrinks due to stress and lack of stimulation, which can lead to permanent losses of synaptic connections. The period of brain development between three and six years is characterized by the generation of brain synapses.

Brain Development in Adolescence

Development in adolescents can progress at a faster rate. The period between the ages of thirteen and fifteen years is considered an age of rebellion characterized by feelings of loneliness, indecision, and emotional fluctuation. During this period, the synapses in the brain can be significantly pruned back, a process called apoptosis. Children who have positive day-to-day connections usually have normal development.

Brain Development into Early Adulthood

During early childhood, there is a decrease in generated synaptic matter which can limit the functioning of lower limbs. However, white matter development allows greater control over body movement such as running and jumping. Myelination improves nerve functions involved in controlling movements while potentially reducing sensitivity to bumps and falls resulting from decreased abrasions for children during this phase of their growth.

The human body possesses an endocannabinoid system that maintains signal transmission equilibrium to avoid excessive synapse generation. This system synthesizes natural cannabinoids, which activate receptors and aid appetite stimulation and suppress nausea while maintaining homeostasis processes. Additionally, the endocannabinoid system produces its own compounds for cell communication related to memory retention, sensation processing and emotional regulation, among other functions. However, the introduction of cannabis alters brain receptor activity by mimicking natural cannabinoid effects leading to altered cognitive abilities such as coordination impairment over time.



The human mind is a fragile entity that requires nurturing surroundings for healthy growth and positive development. During the teenage and pre-adolescent years, the body and mind react differently compared to adults. Cannabis consumption during this developmental stage can lead to an increase in hormone levels causing emotional complexities such as fatigue, exhaustion, nervousness among others. It also impacts cognitive functions leading to impaired brain activities.

Substance abuse and poor Academic Performance:

Smoking cannabis at a young age can have adverse effects on both academic and personal development. The cannabinoid receptor CB1, a key neurotransmitter responsible for learning, problem-solving abilities, and anxiety management is affected by the drug. Cannabis use often lowers endorphin levels in humans which includes dopamine hormones that induce pleasure to the body leading to emotional turmoil like depression or mood swings.

Psychosis:

Psychosis involves experiencing delusions and losing touch with reality, which can be accelerated by cannabis use in children, teenagers, and adults. The effects include disrupted sleep patterns and altered dreams as well as physical symptoms such as bloodshot eyes and an increased heart rate commonly referred to as heart palpitations.

While the debate surrounding cannabis legalization persists, it is essential to prioritize the well-being of our young generation. The importance of waiting until the brain and body are fully developed before experimenting with cannabis cannot be stressed enough. By delaying cannabis use until adulthood, we provide our youth with the best chance at reaching their full potential while minimizing potential risks associated with early substance exposure.
